MORE DEPTH IN COMMUNICATION MOTOR SKILLS AND MOVEMENT Appear more social and alert Still need you to support their head Communicate in "crying differences"—I'm hungry; Seem more in control of their arms and legs I'm excited; I'm uncomfortable Lift the chin off the ground when lying on belly Cry when unattended, then seem happier when Begin to reach and grasp for items held Make "happy sounds" when content and **VISION AND HEARING** comfortable Make more consistent eye contact Begin to follow objects with their eyes Relax when making eye contact Begin to "look around" O Seem happiest when in your arms Begin to look in the direction of some sounds Smile more consistently, especially with eye contact, and more with familiar faces
